1st day: LARNACA - KRAKOW - ZAKOPANE Gathering at Larnaca airport and departure for Krakow with an intermediate station. Arrival, pickup and departure to Poland's winter capital Zakopane, one of the most charming and beautiful places in the country. Arrival and check-in at the hotel. Overnight.

2nd day: ZAKOPANE After breakfast we will explore the green Zakopane, among the picturesque streets of the city with its many restaurants, cafes and shops. Then an exciting experience awaits you, where you will take a cable car to the top of the mountain "Gubalowka", to admire the view and stroll among the local souvenir shops as well as elaborate wood carvings. You can also try local delicacies, as well as the musky meats grilled over wood. The rest of the day free at your disposal to do your walks and shopping. Overnight.

Day 3: ZAKOPANE – AUSCHWITZ – KRAKOW Breakfast and departure for the largest Nazi concentration camp, Auschwitz to visit the crematoria of the Nazi occupation where more than 4,000,000 people, of 28 different nationalities, met their death. We continue to probably the most beautiful city in Poland, Krakow. Arrival and check-in at the hotel. In the evening we suggest you take a romantic carriage ride through the streets of the old town. Overnight.

Day 4: KRAKOW (SIGHTSEEING) - WIELITSKA - KRAKOW The guided tour of this beautiful city that is a magnet for millions of tourists begins after breakfast. We will start from the main square, Rynek Glovny which is one of the largest in Europe, to see the old cloth market and the famous church of Panagia, the church tower and hear the famous trumpet call, the Barbican, the Florianska Street and the oldest Collegium Maius building of the University of Krakow founded in 1364. We will cross the Royal Polish Road to Babel to see the Castle and Cathedral. Then we will visit the unique salt mines of Wieliczka, one of the oldest in the world, which since 1950 have been turned into a museum and a wonderful work of art. Since 1978 they have been included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage Sites. There in the bowels of the earth we will admire the various sculptures made of salt but also the wonderful church which has been carved entirely by the salt miners themselves. A unique place in the world that you have definitely not seen before. Return to Krakow and overnight stay.

Day 5: KRAKOW - CZECHTOCHOWA - WARSAW After breakfast we will depart for Czestochowa, the religious capital of Poland. Here we will visit the Yasna Gora monastery with the unique and famous icon of the Black Virgin. We continue with the final destination the capital Warsaw. Arrival and check-in at the hotel. In the evening you can watch a spectacle in the multimedia fountain, and enjoy a spectacle of sound, color and music. Overnight.

Day 6: WARSAW Breakfast and city tour. Warsaw is full of sights and monuments of culture and art, which, although completely destroyed during the Second World War, were reconstructed with faithful and detailed reproduction from historical documents, sketches, paintings and photographs, restoring the old and the new city of Warsaw. We will start from Sigmund's Column, the oldest statue in Warsaw and the Castle of the Kings. We continue to "Lazenki" which is a complex of palaces and parks in Warsaw and we will take a guided tour of the grounds of the famous royal palace "Palace on the Water". We will pass through the main street Marsalkowska, with its many shops where the Palace of Culture and Science is located. Rest of the day free. The city's largest department store "Zlote Tarasy" awaits you for your shopping. Overnight.

7th day: WARSAW – VILANOV PALACE – ZELAZOVA WOLA – LARNACA After breakfast we will depart for the historic Vilanov Palace, which was lucky enough not to be destroyed by the two world wars and is located in the area of the same name. The Palace is a baroque royal residence surrounded by beautiful gardens. Then we will visit Zelazów Wola, the birthplace of Frédéric Chopin, the famous Polish composer. We continue to Warsaw airport to catch the return flight. Arrival in Larnaca at dawn on the 8th day clearly impressed by a country with wonderful architecture, beautiful landscapes, but also a rich history.
